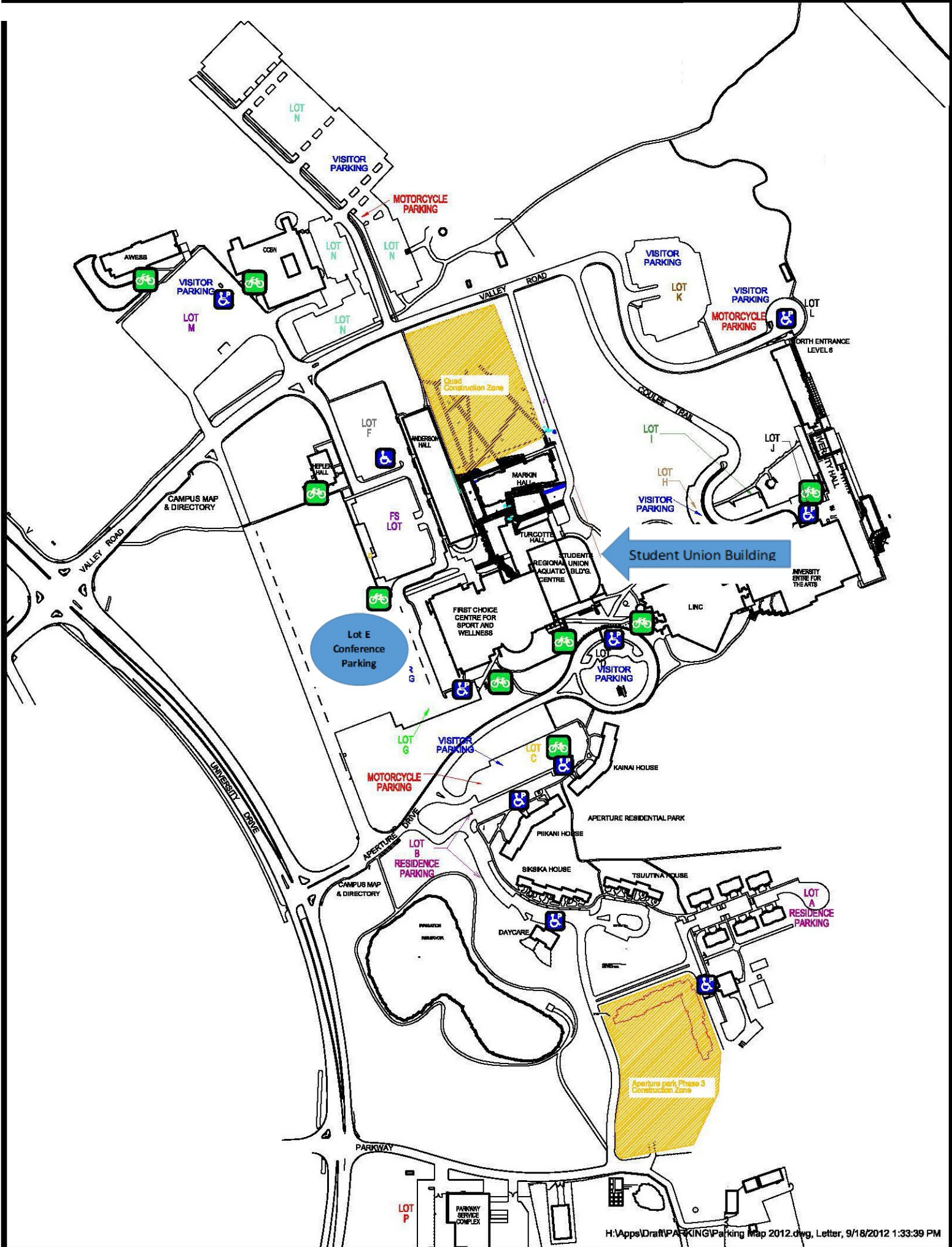

Getting to the University of Lethbridge, coming from downtown Lethbridge:

1. Drive west on 6th Avenue south and continue west; this avenue turns into Whoop Up Drive and goes over a bridge toward the west side of the city.
2. Take University Drive North ramp (exit on your right) towards HWY3/HWY 25. Stay right onto University Drive West
3. Turn left on Valley Road and this takes you on to campus (at the lights you'll see the road is Columbia Blvd on your right and Valley Rd on your left). Go into the right lane.
4. Drive along Valley Road and take your first right turn, watch for signs guiding you to Beulah Salt conference parking in Lot E.
5. **The Conference is in the Student Union Ballrooms A&B.** Once you've parked your car in Lot E, cross the parking lot walking east (towards the campus buildings – you'll see Anderson Hall (a long, low brown building on your left) and First Choice Savings Center (a large building on your right) and Turcotte Hall (directly in front of you). Enter Turcotte Hall and follow the signs directing you to the Student Union Building (you will walk through Turcotte Hall and when you exit Turcotte Hall the Student Union Building is on your left). Enter the Student Union Building and go up the flight of stairs, walk past The Zoo (it's a pub) and the Student Union Ballrooms are on your left. If you require an elevator, proceed past the stairs and on your right (before the bathrooms) there is an elevator – you will go up to level 3.

Getting to the University of Lethbridge, coming from the west:

1. Take HWY 25 S exit toward West Lethbridge North/Picture Butte and take ramp toward West Lethbridge/Paradise Canyon
2. Merge onto University Drive West
3. Continue along University Drive West for approx 5 km
4. Turn left on Valley Road and this takes you on to campus (at the lights you'll see the road is Columbia Blvd on your right and Valley Rd on your left).
5. Drive along Valley Road and take your first right turn, watch for signs guiding you to Beulah Salt conference parking in Lot E.
6. **The Conference is in the Student Union Ballrooms A&B.** Once you've parked your car in Lot E, cross the parking lot walking east (towards the campus buildings – you'll see Anderson Hall (a long, low brown building on your left) and First Choice Savings Center (a large building on your right) and Turcotte Hall (directly in front of you). Enter Turcotte Hall and follow the signs directing you to the Student Union Building (you will walk through Turcotte Hall and when you exit Turcotte Hall the Student Union Building is on your left). Enter the Student Union Building and go up the flight of stairs, walk past The Zoo (it's a pub) and the Ballrooms are on your left. If you require an elevator, proceed past the stairs and on your right (before the bathrooms) there is an elevator – you will go up to level 3.

Getting to the University, coming from the south:

1. Driving north on University Drive west, access the campus from the south entrance by turning right at the lights at the intersection of University Drive West and Aperture Drive West.
2. Drive along Aperture Drive West, take the first left turn and watch for signs guiding you to Beulah Salt conference parking in Lot E.
3. ***The Conference is in the Student Union Ballrooms A&B.*** Once you've parked your car in Lot E, cross the parking lot walking east (towards the buildings – you'll see Anderson Hall (a long, low brown building on your left) and First Choice Savings Center (a large building on your right) and Turcotte Hall (directly in front of you). Enter Turcotte Hall and follow the signs directing you to the Student Union Building (you will walk through Turcotte Hall and when you exit Turcotte Hall the Student Union Building is on your left). Enter the Student Union Building and go up the flight of stairs, walk past The Zoo (it's a pub) and the Student Union Ballrooms are on your left.
